Microfinance Helps Local Entrepreneurs

The eleven members of Rajabu Omari’s family depend on him for support — shelter, food, clothes, education, and health care. Like most families in the impoverished Yullansoni Valley, the Omaris struggle to meet their daily needs. No traditional financial institution would extend a loan to Mr. Omari without collateral, and collateral is precisely what he didn’t have.

Mr. Omari’s financial dream was realized on February 7, 2009, when he received a \$500 loan from FDM’s Rural Microfinance Credit Facility. The purpose of the loan was to upgrade his door-to-door clothing business, known as “Mtumba Shop.” When FDM’s consultant visited Mr. Omari to review his business progress, “Mtumba Shop” had done so well that Mr. Omari was eligible for a second loan. On July 30 Mr. Rajabu made the last repayment on his first loan, which enabled him to then get a second loan in the amount of \$600.

Today Mr. Omari is a living testimony to the benefits of microfinance. He now is able to employ three other persons. He is able to provide his family with a balanced diet and help his children to get a better education. He has even been able to save some money for future needs.

Mr. Omari represents many others for whom an FDM microfinance loan has made a world of difference. Thanks to The Journey Foundation for their generous grant to initiate this FDM ministry!

Pastor William Is Coming to the US

Pastor William will be visiting the US in March 2010 to update supporters on the work of FDM in TZ. His tentative itinerary looks like this:

Early March — arrive in California

Mid-March — in South Carolina

Late March — in Massachusetts

Early April — depart for TZ

Clinic Certified at Highest Level

Recently FDM’s clinic at Yulansoni was inspected by the district-level medical officers, who certified the clinic at the highest level. What this means for the future of the clinic:

- **New Staff Nurse:**

The clinic is now eligible for the services of a high-level nurse. Once the clinic provides housing for the nurse and her family, the government will pay the nurse’s salary.

- **Immunization Center:**

The clinic will be an Immunization Center for the Yulansoni Valley. This classification means that vaccines and special medications will be provided by the Tanzanian government.

Grant Will Enable Pre-school Upgrade

From beginning to end, the growth and development of FDM is the story of God’s amazing grace. But every now and then we are blessed with special reminders of God’s goodness. In 2009 FDM applied for a grant from the Journey Foundation for the \$5,380 needed to bring the pre-school facility up to governmental standards. The Foundation generously awarded us \$4,000. Meanwhile, friends at Mauldin UMC were raising money by serving Wednesday night church family suppers. The total raised by the suppers? \$1,466, or \$86 more than our target!

Look for exciting news on this project in the months ahead:

- Install concrete floor
- Build separate toilet facilities
- Install a door and six windows
- Plaster, seal, and paint interior and exterior walls
- Build separate storage for teacher’s supplies
